	 YHSI/YHDP challenges: lost some TA folks; have intentionally created a distinction between the two programs bc they are similar but different; TAs have had contracts revoked have lived expertise (POC, LGBTQ+, more Woke) and likely because they are from subcontractors that had DEI language in them. Youth Collaboratory still has lived experience and is still involved. Krysta pointed out that there was too much TA for YHDP and it was expensive. YHSI hours have decreased from 8-10 per month to 2 per month.
